Clarifications

- During the second year of the Master, Double Degree students must pass 4 elective long courses (or 8 short courses or 2 long courses and 4 short courses) with enough credits to satisfy the demand of both programs and that shall be defined with the coordinator of both schools;

- Elective courses belonging to the Master in Management (*Administração*) at Insper will be accepted to the Nova SBE Master pending analysis of the coordinators;
- In the case of students from Insper that will study at Nova SBE, courses at Nova SBE must be equivalent in class hours to the requisites of the Master at Insper. Due to the workload of the courses, 2 short courses at Nova SBE are equivalent to 1 elective at Insper (36 hours);
- If a Nova SBE student has not done a course considered equivalent to the mandatory ones at Insper, he/ she must do it along with the 4 elective courses mentioned above and the thesis.
- The final Work Project must be in English.
- Participating students in the Double Degree Nova SBE – Insper must stay at least 6 months in the partner university. The development of the Work Project (remaining 6 months) may be done at the home university.
- Internship option: Nova SBE students participating in this Double Degree may do an internship in Brazil (if the Brazilian law and the student's visa allow so) after concluding the first trimester at Insper and upon analysis by the Master's Coordination and the Career services on the student's performance.
